
## **Home Connection**

In Chapter 11, your child will build on the foundation of addition and subtraction that was learned in the previous two chapters. In this chapter, your child will explore the connection between addition and subtraction, starting with a number bond, then moving to number sentences. By the end of the chapter, your child should be able to tell an addition or subtraction story based on a picture and to determine what addition or subtraction equation is necessary to solve a given situation or story.



## Math at Home

- Continue practicing for automaticity with addition and subtraction sentences to 10.
- Playing board games, like Chutes and Ladders®, with your child will help him count on or back on a number path.
- Play 1 More, 1 Less, or the Same As. Remove the face cards from a deck of playing cards. The ace is 1. Shuffle and deal out 5 cards to each player to start. Place the remaining cards in the middle. Flip the top card to start. Players take turns playing a card from their hand that is either 1 more, 1 less, or the same as the card showing. If no card can be played, a card is drawn and added to that player's hand. The winner is the player who plays all of her cards first.
