Helpful reminders:

- Dimensions Math digital subscriptions are licensed on a *one-user-per-resource* basis. Each teacher or student who needs access to a specific eBook or video must have their own individual subscription to that resource.
- Dimensions Math video subscriptions can be purchased on their own, while eBook subscriptions are offered as affordable add-ons to the corresponding physical book titles and quantities. To help ensure smooth access for your users, please ensure a subscription has been purchased on behalf of each applicable user.
- Access to digital resources for Primary Mathematics Singapore International Edition is included with your PM SIE bundle purchase. To obtain a new subscription, a new bundle must be purchased.

### **Can more than one user share the same account?**

No. Accounts may not be shared.

Each user must have their own individual account to ensure proper access, assignment tracking, and data integrity.

### **Can multiple users share a single subscription?**

No. Digital subscriptions are licensed per user, per resource.

Each teacher or student who needs access to a specific eBook or video must have their own individual subscription.

### **Which resources are printable?**

- Printable availability varies by resource.
- Due to copyright restrictions, Textbooks, Workbooks, Tests, and Teacher's Guides cannot be printed, copied, or otherwise reproduced.

### **How long do subscriptions last?**

Digital subscriptions are valid for one year from the date of purchase.

### **Does the platform sync with Single Sign-On (SSO) services or Learning Management Systems (LMS)?**

At this time, the Singapore Math Hub does not integrate with Single Sign-On (SSO) services or external Learning Management Systems (LMS).



Our platform is intentionally designed as a focused, content-delivery system rather than a full student information or grading system. This allows us to:

**1. Maintain Simplicity and Reliability**

By keeping the login and class management system streamlined, we reduce technical complexity and minimize integration-related issues that can disrupt instruction.

**2. Protect Student Privacy**

Avoiding third-party integrations ensures tighter control over student account data and reduces external data-sharing dependencies.

**3. Provide Consistent Access Across Schools**

Schools use a wide variety of LMS and SSO systems. Rather than building and maintaining multiple integrations, we provide a standardized login experience that works the same way for all users.

**4. Support Younger Learners**

Most Singapore Math classrooms serve elementary students. Teacher-managed usernames and passwords are often simpler and more practical than district-level SSO workflows.

**5. Prioritize Instructional Experience**

Our platform is designed primarily for content access, assignment tracking, and classroom presentation—not as a gradebook or SIS replacement. Keeping the system focused allows us to optimize performance and usability.
